EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Educational scholarships will be awarded based on, in categories such as Academic, Extracurricular, Community Service will be granted to deserving, qualified male students. Selected students will be awarded a scholarship up to the amount of \$2,000. The scholarship is payable to the student, in one lump sum, upon verification of enrollment as a full-time student at an accredited college, university or vocational school. Selection Criteria:

1. Scholarships are open to **male students** in the following categories:
 - **Senior high school students** who live or attend high schools (public & private) on the island of Oahu.
 - **An undergraduate college student/trade or vocational school student** that graduated within the last three years from a high school in Hawaii and continuing their education.
2. An eligible candidate must have a 3.00-grade point average (GPA) or better on a 4.0 Scale.
3. An eligible candidate must be enrolling as a full-time student in a 2 or 4-year accredited college or university in the fall semester.
4. Eligible students must:
 - Complete the Personal Information section
 - Upload a high school, college, or vocational school transcript.
 - Upload your standardized test scores (SAT/ACT). **Note: required for high school seniors only**
 - Write an essay of no more than **500** words.
 - Complete a detailed listing of all extracurricular activities.
 - Complete the section on community service/volunteer activity summary.
 - Upload at least three letters of recommendation.
 - Upload letters of acceptance to college, university, or trade school.

Failure to submit all required components may result in automatic dismissal of the scholarship application.

Scholarship Prizes:

- 1st Place Winner: \$2,000
- 2nd Place Winner: \$1,500
- 3rd Place Winner: \$1,000

Next Steps:

Once your scholarship application is submitted, please allow up to three weeks from the close of the submittal period for review. At the conclusion of the review, a representative from the Honolulu Alumni Chapter will contact you regarding your status in the selection process. A virtual award ceremony for scholarship recipients will take place in June of this year where the scholarship awards will be presented to the awardees.
